

WINTERTHUR WILL CLOSE FOR THE SEASON AT 5:00 PM ON JANUARY 6, 2013

The Museum, Garden & Library Will Reopen to the Public at 10:00 am on March 1, 2013

Winterthur, DE—Winterthur Museum, Garden & Library will close for the winter season at 5:00 pm on January 6, 2013, and reopen to the public at 10:00 am on March 1, 2013.

During this time, Winterthur will undertake renovations and upgrades in some public areas to make visitor spaces more comfortable. Improvement projects include the refurbishment of the Museum Tour Reception Area, the addition of four handicapped/van-accessible parking spaces, and the installation of various fire and security system upgrades, among others.

Winterthur also will use the time to make preparations for the upcoming major exhibition, *Common Destinations: Maps in the American Experience*, which will be open from April 20, 2013, to January 5, 2014. *Common Destinations* will examine the varied ways that Americans from all economic and geographic backgrounds interacted with maps from the 1750s through the 1870s. This exhibition will feature over 100 selections from Winterthur's fascinating collection of traditional maps on paper as well as map-related objects such as geographic playing cards, ceramics, children's samplers, and more.

Winterthur Members will have access to the grounds and garden during the hiatus on a dawn-to-dusk, Tuesday–Sunday schedule, weather permitting. The Winterthur Library will continue to provide service to scholars and researchers.
