Craft of the week: Fun Photo Opps

Two color photographs of yourself (one of your face & one of your entire body)

Drawing paper Colored Pencils

Scissors Glue

1. On the first (facial) photo, trim the background so all that remains is your face and neck.

2. Fold the face in half vertically, dividing it into two equal sections.

3. Open it up and cut down the fold.

4. Glue one half of the face to a piece of paper.5. Use colored pencils to draw the other side of the

face, trying to recreate missing features.
6. On the second (body) photo, trim background by cutting around the head, shoulders and body. Turn the photo face side down.

7. Use a ruler and pencil to draw lines 1/2- to 1-inch apart, across the back side of the image.

8. Cut through these lines to make strips

9. Turn the photo strips face up and glue them onto a large sheet of paper, leaving 1/2- to 1-inch between each strip to create an elongated image.
