Family Program Teaches How Art Helps Unify Societies

WHAT: Children and their parents are invited to explore art from around the world at Winterthur's upcoming Terrific Tuesday family program.

WHEN: Tuesday, July 30, 2013, 10:00 am–3:00 pm.

WHERE: Winterthur Museum, Garden & Library, 5105 Kennett Pike, Winterthur, Delaware, 19735.

BACKGROUND: Winterthur's next Terrific Tuesday will take children on a journey around the world through art, exploring the similarities and differences in the ways cultures interpret the world around them. Children will make a passport and "jet off" to different destinations around the globe. As they travel from Egypt to China and beyond, hands-on activities will teach them more about the various ways art is created in other societies and in America.

Terrific Tuesdays continue in August, exploring new themes in art and nature each week.

Activities are geared toward children ages 3 to 10. Admission to this drop-in program also allows families to tour the museum, stroll in the gardens, or take a tram ride after they have taken part in the program.
